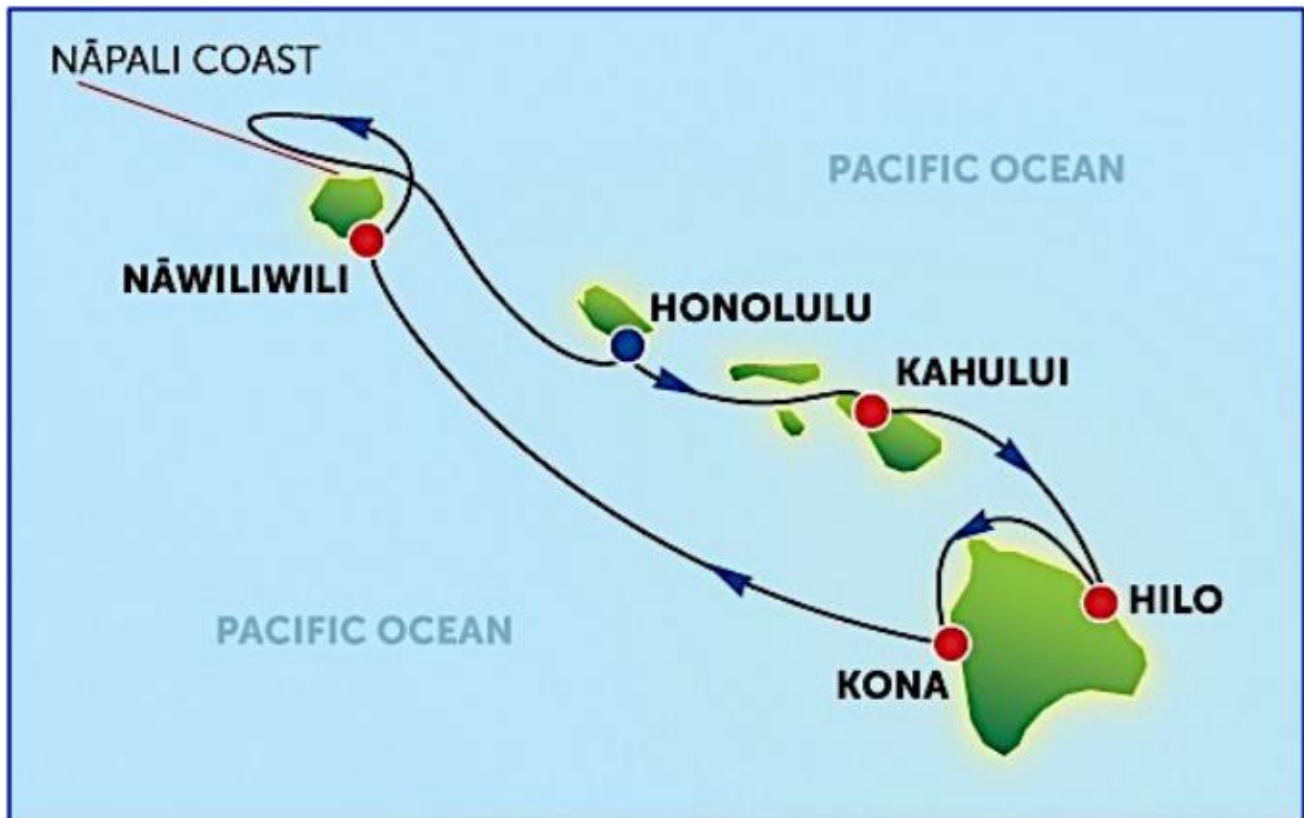

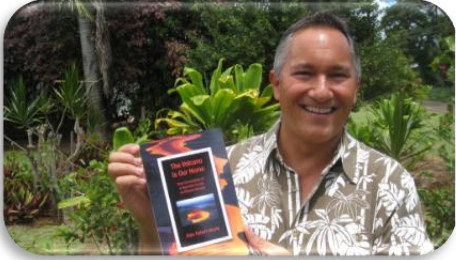

1. [KAHIKOLU CONGREGATIONAL CHURCH](#),
Napo'opo'o
Built in 1855, and listed on the National Register of Historic Places, is the burial site of Henry 'Ōpūkaha'ia, one of the first native Hawaiians to become a Christian.
2. [MOKUAIKAU CONGREGATIONAL CHURCH](#), Kona
Hawaii's first Christian Church. Enjoy a guided tour commemorating the 200th anniversary of Christian missionaries to Hawaii.
3. [QUEEN EMMA'S HULIHE'E PALACE](#),
Kailua-Kona
Restored and maintained by "Daughters of Hawaii," the Palace today is a museum showcasing Victorian artifacts from the era of King Kalākaua and Queen Kapi'olani.
